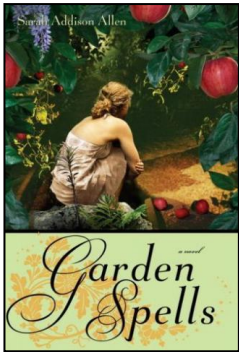


2010 Bee Cave Book Club Selections

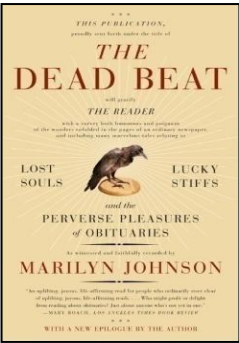

April 8 – *Garden Spells*, by Sarah Addison Allen.

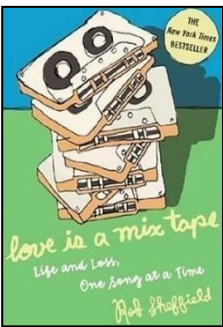
