Bee Cave Public Library is pleased to offer its patrons an amazing genealogy research tool, **Ancestry® Library Edition**, which gives patrons instant access to a wide range of unique resources. With more than 5 billion names in over 3,400 databases, Ancestry Library Edition includes records from the United States census; military records; court, land, and probate records; vital and church records; directories; passenger lists, and more. Similar information is also available for the United Kingdom, Canada and some European countries. Under the terms of our licensing agreement, Ancestry Library Edition may only be accessed from within the library.

Ancestry Library Edition is a strong complement to **HeritageQuest™ Online**, which is available through the **TexShare Databases**. HeritageQuest, like other TexShare Databases, may be accessed from home by using a logon and password available at the library.

Some of the collections available through Ancestry include U.S. Federal Census images and indexes from 1790 to 1930; the Map Center containing more than 1,000 historical maps; *American Genealogical Biographical Index* (over 200 volumes); *Daughters of the American Revolution Lineage* (over 150 volumes); *The Great Migration Begins: Immigrants to New England, 1620-1630*; *Social Security Death Index* (updated monthly); *WWI Draft Registration Cards*; *Federal Slave Narratives*; and a strong Civil War collection. Ancestry Library Edition updates continually, with more indexes and original images added all the time.
