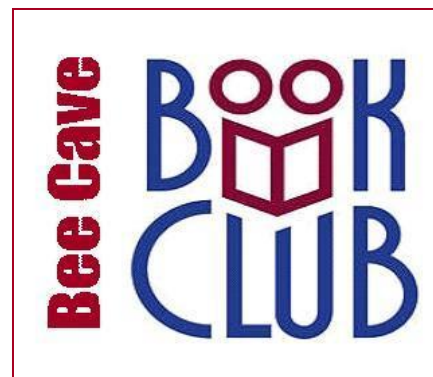


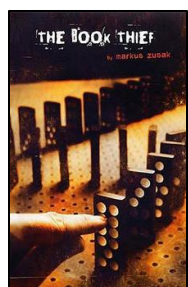
Book Club Selections for 2011
